A full and valid passport is required for all persons traveling to any of the destinations outside the U.S. that we feature (if appropriate). U.S. Citizens Travel Requirements to European Countries

U.S. citizens can travel to most European countries without a visa for up to 90 days within a 180-day period. Here are the key points:

1. **Schengen Area:** The Schengen area includes most European Union (EU) countries, except for Cyprus and Ireland. It also includes four non-EU countries: Iceland, Norway, Switzerland, and Liechtenstein.
2. **Passport Validity:** Your U.S. passport must be valid for at least six months from your entry date into the Schengen area.
3. **Border-Free Travel:** The Schengen Borders Agreement allows you to move freely within these countries without border checks.
4. **Entry Requirements:**
 1. Always carry your passport with you.
 2. Be prepared to explain your purpose of travel.
 3. Show proof of sufficient financial resources.
 4. Comply with other entry requirements for each country you visit.
5. **ETIAS Authorization (Starting May 2025):** U.S. citizens will need an ETIAS authorization to travel to Europe. [It's an online application process that requires a valid passport, an email account, and a credit or debit card](#)
